To do

- Each partner presents 2 or 3 different activities to teach a foreign language in a refugee class (15 minutes for each team) (= **Homework 01 for everybody**)
- Presenting **tools for testing and evaluating language competencies** of refugees (before the first lesson of a language course and after the last lesson of a language course (15 minutes each partner) (= **Homework 02 for everybody**))
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Overview of Veneto Region opportunity courses Italian languages as L2

- ▶ **Fund Asylum, Migration and Integration 2014-2020 - Specific Objective 2. Integrazione / Legal migration - National Objective 2. Integration - lett. h) linguistic Civic Education.**
- ▶ C.I.V.I.S. project aiming to ensure an increasing linguistic and social integration of foreigners legally present in Veneto Region, promoting reception services, language and civic training, provided by the CPIA (Permanent Center for Adult Education), a network of public schools.
- ▶ **They were made 5 year of the project starting from 2011.**
- ▶ The overall goal of the project is to promote the best conditions for integration and active social participation for third nationals country residing in the region, promoting actions aiming to improve the knowledge of the Italian language and civic education among non-EU immigrants.



CIVIS V COURSES of Italian language FOR 2017

- A) 100 times modules to achieve the A1 level (equivalent to 10,000 hours of classroom and 1,000 hours of receipt-orientation-evaluation for a total of 11,000 hours of services-teaching to be delivered to students);
- B) n. 75 modules aimed at achieving the A2 level (equivalent to 6750 hours of services-teaching to be delivered to students);
- C) n. 50 courses aimed at achieving the Pre A1 level from 10 to 150 hours each;
- D) 25 courses aimed at achieving the B1 level from 80 to 100 hours each

for a total of 26,000 hours of training provided (A + B + C + D)

CIVIS V courses are for: Third-country nationals, beneficiaries of international protection or who already has the status of political refugee.



OTHER COURSES OPPORTUNITY IN ITALY

SPRAR: Protection System for Asylum Seekers and Refugees

It's a network of local institutions that implements reception projects for forced migrants, by accessing the National Fund for Asylum Policies and Services, managed by the Ministry of the Interior.


SPRAR hosts asylum seekers, and beneficiaries of international protection, or who already has the status of political refugee

Main characteristics:

- | the decentralisation of the 'integrated reception' actions, throughout Italy
- | the voluntary participation of local institutions in the network of reception projects
- | the temporary nature of reception

SPRAR includes 640 projects for 25.838 places in total (654 places in Veneto region. Data 2017).

Around 150.000 other asylum seekers in Italy are hosted in temporary projects (CAS- Centri di Accoglienza Straordinaria, CARA - Centro Accoglienza Richiedenti Asilo, Hotspot. Data 2016).



OTHER COURSES OPPORTUNITY

SPRAR projects include legal and social guidance and support, and the development of individual programmes to promote socioeconomic inclusion and integration.

10 hours a week of Italian language lesson must be provided by the hosting organization to all recipients, during all their permanence in the project.

It can be provided through specific courses organized by the hosting organization, or through enrolling in existing Italian courses in the local area (CPIA- Permanent Center for Adult Education, voluntary associations, ...).



OTHER COURSES OPPORTUNITY AROUND VENICE

- GEA (Mestre): courses of basic Italian language for foreigners seeking international protection, in agreement with the Prefecture of Venice and with the Prefecture of Treviso.
- OLIVOTTI (Mira): courses of basic Italian language for foreign women. This training project is also accompanied by others for the prevention of domestic accidents.
- OPERE RIUNITE BUON PASTORE (Venice): reception and integration of families, minors and adults seeking asylum and international protection holders.
