# data - veneto

In Veneto region:

- foreigners living in Veneto are about 511.000 = 10% of population  
they come from:

Romania

Marocco

Albania

Moldova

Cina

- asylum seekers: over 2.000
- rejected asylum: about 48%

# asylum seeker

- in 2 months they are allowed to work
- they should attend italian language classes inside project (at least 120h) and in public school (CPIA). level preA1 to B1.
- MSNA have to attend ordinary school
- AGE: the great majority: 20-30 aged
- GENDER: male 80%
- between 20 and 30% of illiterate or low literacy people. So it's hard to involve them in schooling/working path.

# career guidance: **themes**

- jobs, how to search / apply for a job
- different work contract
- CV
- rights and duties
- education (italian course, diplomas, high school)
- housing (rules, contract)
- computer/smartphone literacy

# career guidance: **inside class**

## **inclusion is strongly linked to italian learning**

- italian words for job, education, housing
- how the system works
- asking/search for a job (role plays, intercultural aspects)
- educational system and library service
- free wifi
- driving licence (road signs, bicycle, cars, parking,.. )
- useful websites
- study visit in the city to related office (labor agency, employment center, library, registry office, estate agency..)

# special **workshop**

these workshop are useful to give tools to refugees

- job market and italian L2 (words, cv, job ad..)
- ICT and italian L2 (self access to online exercise)
- computer literacy (cloud, mail, attachments, google search, pdfs, word, google maps, smartphone..)

# career guidance: **outside class**

**refugees need to learn italian (at least A2) before attending expert meetings**

- group and individual career guidance: 4 group basis and 4 individual meeting led by counselor (cv, career management skills, job market, job interview training..)
- housing: 2 meeting led by expert to all asylum seeker (rules, searching a flat, contract..)
